- (2) **Civil and Environmental Engineering:** Structural Engineering and Structural Materials, Geotechnical and Underground Space Engineering, Mobility Management Engineering, Hydraulic Engineering, Glaciology and Gas Hydrate Engineering, and Others.
- (3) **Information and Communication Engineering:** Intelligent System Design, Optics and Image Science, Smart Engineering of Knowledge, Discovery and Data Mining, Mathematical and Computational Science, and Others.
- (4) **Applied Chemistry:** Advanced Materials Chemistry, Advanced Materials Engineering, and Others.
